




PAEDIATRIC URINE CULTURE FROM BAG

Instructions for sample collection

PROCEDURE	<p>Carry out an adequate cleaning and cleansing of the genital area using water and soap. Spread the child's legs wide apart. Ensure that the skin of pubis and perineum is clean and perfectly dry (use disposable paper to dry). Do not apply any powders, oils or lotions to the skin.</p>
	<div style="display: flex; align-items: flex-start;"> <div style="margin-right: 10px;">  <p>1</p> </div> <div> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Remove the protective paper from the hypoallergenic adhesive surface (Fig. 1). </div> </div>
	<div style="display: flex; align-items: flex-start;"> <div style="margin-right: 10px;">  <p>2</p> </div> <div> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> For females: Tighten the skin of the perineum (Fig. 2) to avoid skin folds. Press the adhesive part on the skin around the vagina. Start this operation from the area that separates the anal orifice from the vagina and keep on acting on the adhesive surface from bottom to top. </div> </div>
<div style="display: flex; align-items: flex-start;"> <div style="margin-right: 10px;">  <p>3</p> </div> <div> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> For males: Place the bag with the opening where the penis is (Fig. 3), press the adhesive strips vigorously on the perineum avoiding the formation of creases, and make sure that the entire adhesive surface sticks to the skin well. </div> </div>	
STORAGE	Deliver the container to the Blood and Urine Test Centre in accordance with the opening hours, within 2 hours of collection.
REMARKS	Follow the procedure described.
